<u>HB 655</u> -does not include 9-1-1 but will affect 9-1-1 Officer training related to a peace officer training committee

<u>HB 354</u> – Exemption of Jury Duty for fire fighters and police officers TC's should be included in this exemption

Federal Legislation- National 91-1- has not put out any information as to what will be discussed for 91-1- goes to Washington.

March 3-5, 2019 is 9-1-1- goes to Austin.
